# News from the Sugarbush ~ Growing up Maple ~

Every year the excitement started in January. We would see Dad starting to organize the space in the sugar camp, moving boxes and cleaning every surface. As a family we would all start paying closer attention to Bob's Garden weather report on CKVR; waiting for daytime temperatures of 5° and night time of -5° and before you knew it, it was "go" time. The day we would get off the school bus and see that Dad had tapped the front trees with buckets was our cue to run through the bush to find him and start asking when we can start boiling sap.

We could tell when sap started significantly collecting by the noise of the vacuum pump running all day and sometimes at night. When I was really young, before the neighbourhood of Ritchie Crescent was built, we were able to see from our school yard across the farmers fields to the 8th concession. When smoke would rise from just the right spot, we knew Dad was boiling and would tell anyone who had ears.

Most of our evenings were spent in the sugar shack, visiting with cousins who came to help, aunts, uncles and other family and friends who stopped by every year to relive and retell their stories of sugaring off at the Lalonde's Sugar Shack since 1958. And of course working our first paid jobs - giving guided tours.

It was my duty to bring out meals for everyone and I loved eating every dinner by the heat of the evaporator, listening to the jokes, banter, stories and

soaking up the shared knowledge. Both Dad and I are spring babies so our birthdays were celebrated with cake and the smell of wood smoke and maple syrup in the sugar camp. Sometimes after all the food I would find someone napping under the flu pans or in the morning before heading to the bus we would wake Dad from his nap in front of the evaporator - having stayed out in the camp all night because you make syrup when the sap is flowing (meaning sometimes you work for days without a break).

Our spring class trips were always to my houseimagine taking your regular bus to school, getting on another bus just to come back home with all your class mates. Everyone asking questions about something you witness daily, being amazed that I have such easy access to candy and syrup - so much candy and syrup that I pass up on the free samples!

Now, I am Mother to three very sweet girls who love to put Grampy's maple syrup on everything from pancakes to cereal, veggies to toast and directly into their mouths when Mom and Dad aren't looking. I am looking forward to sharing my memories and experiences with them as they grow, making new ones together.

Maybe upon your visit to Lalonde's Maple Sugar Bush you will catch us sharing a meal by the fire while telling jokes and stories... if you're lucky.

# Cooking and Baking with Maple Syrup

Maple syrup is a wonderful substitute for regular sweeteners in a variety of beverages and foods. Whether you're baking bread, cakes, cookies or pastries, making glazes, sauces and marinades, sweetening hot drinks or making a meat dish, maple syrup is an easy substitute for honey, molasses or corn syrup and can replace white sugar if quantities are adjusted correctly.

It can be substituted 1/1 with honey, molasses and corn syrup, and you can replace one cup of white sugar with one and a half cups of maple syrup, adding a ¼ teaspoon of baking soda for each cup of maple syrup and reducing the amount of liquid in the recipe by half.

Use a grade that suits your own taste, but it is generally found that dark or very dark maple syrup gives a depth and richness to the flavor.

# Celebrate Maple Season

Celebrate maple season at a sugarbush April 6 and 7 during Maple Weekend. Maple syrup season is well underway for 2024 and producers are excited to welcome visitors and showcase the 2024 crop of maple syrup during the 8th annual Maple Weekend, April 6 and 7, 2024.

Hosted by the Ontario Maple Syrup Producers' Association (OMSPA), Maple Weekend is a fun, free, two-day, family-friendly event that celebrates Ontario's maple heritage and invites visitors to head out to visit the sugarbush and savour the flavours of spring.

"Spring is the most exciting time of the year for maple syrup producers, especially when we get an early run as we did this year," said Randal Goodfellow, OMSPA President. "Maple syrup producers across the province are looking forward to opening up their sugarbush for visitors and inviting them to join in the celebration of the sweetest time of the year."

This year marks the 8th annual Maple Weekend, and visitors can expect to experience the best of maple season at a sugarbush on April 6 and 7, 2024. Maple Weekend features two full days of activities and specials at participating sugarbushes across the province. Running from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. both days, at participating sugarbushes visitors can expect to sample maple syrup, get out on the trails in a working sugarbush, eat maple taffy, get an inside peek into how maple syrup is produced, and stock up on this year's crop of maple syrup.

Officially launched in 2015, Maple Weekend has been a tremendous success for both producers and visitors. Maple Weekend is a past nominee for

Destination Ontario's Tourism Event of the Year, and draws roughly 20,000 visitors to rural sugarbushes across the province each year.

In 2024, there will be 75 producers taking part in Maple Weekend, with participants from the following OMSPA districts: Algoma, Algonquin & District, Eastern, Grey-Bruce & District, Haliburton-Kawartha, Lanark & District, Ottawa Valley, Quinte & District, Simcoe & District, Southwestern, and Waterloo-Wellington.

A list of participating Maple Weekend maple syrup producers is available on the Maple Weekend website, along with further details about specials and activities for visitors at the 75 locations across the province. Visitors are invited to visit the Maple Weekend website at www.mapleweekend.ca for more details.

As the official voice of sugar makers in the province, OMSPA represents approximately 600 maple syrup producers from across the province, who are committed to producing a high-quality product for consumers to enjoy. Members are involved with a wide range of activities organized at the provincial level or through one of the 11 local chapters located across the maple producing areas of Ontario.



# FROM THE ARCHIUES

# — The Maple Leaf —

A truly Canadian symbol (from the EMSF supplement to local newspapers in 1979)

The Maple Leaf has become known around the world as a symbol of Canada. It appears on our flag and on our coat of arms, in the arms of the provinces of Ontario and Quebec, and on the Queen's personal Canadian flag.

The leaves used in each case are stylized, so we can't be certain which species was used as a model, but they usually bear a resemblance to our best known maple, the Sugar Maple. Where Sugar Maples grow in Canada, from Nova Scotia to Western Ontario, the trees have made their mark in the history of the land.

Indians first used the sap as a beverage and to make sugar. Early settlers used the wood for fuel, potash and furniture. Loggers cut the trees for lumber, and the glory of the leaves in Autumn endeared the trees to all who saw them.

# The Quickest Blade

## They Came, They Sawed, They Conquered!

Our annual log-sawing contest takes place on our main stage shortly after noon on festival day. Local dignitaries and politicians from nearby municipalities pair up to test their sawing skills, some who have experience and some who are new to the task.

The pine log, donated by Robert Ritchie Forest Products, is set up on stage and referee Doug Kirton hands over his 52" crosscut saw, which has been oiled and sharpened to produce the best result possible.

Our official timer has his stopwatch ready and after a brief practice run, the order to 'go' is given and the contestants work in unison to remove a section of the log in the shortest time. It is much harder than it looks, and anticipating your partner's moves is definitely an asset.

We have two divisions; Open and Ladies'. Our 2023 open division winners were the New Tecumseth team of Councillor Alan Masters and Councillor Chris Rapin. The winners of the ladies' division, representing Springwater Township, were Councillor Danielle Alexander and Councillor Anita Moore.

The winning teams are rewarded by having their names added to our trophy and receiving bottles of delicious maple syrup, plus the bragging rights until the next year. Don't miss the excitement!

# **Ice Taffy**

One of the delights of spring at any sugar bush or festival is the making and eating of ice taffy. Children and adults alike relish this sweet treat and also love to join in the making of their own taffy.

A quantity of syrup is poured onto clean snow or ice shavings. It will stiffen into firm taffy which can then be rolled onto a stick or eaten directly off the snow.

Don't miss the ice taffy display, presented by the Township of Springwater, at this year's festival.





# Maple Glazed Chicken

Tender chicken glazed with the rich sweetness of pure maple syrup paired with tart lemon and nutty almonds combine to make delicious flavors. Pair this delicious recipe with steamed rice and a kale salad for a complete meal.

### Ingredients:

- · 4 chicken breasts boneless skinless
- 1/2 cup pure maple syrup
- 1/2 cup butter melted
- 1/2 cup slivered almonds
- 1 Tablespoon fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon grated lemon rind
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- Cracked black pepper

### Preparation:

Place your chicken breasts in the bottom of a shallow baking pan. Mix all remaining ingredients and pour the sauce over top of the chicken.

Bake the chicken for 35 – 45 minutes in a 375° preheated oven, basting at least twice during cooking. When the internal temperature of the breast reaches 160 degrees, remove the pan from the oven.

Cover the pan with foil, and let the chicken rest for 5 minutes. Serve the chicken over top of rice or butter noodles and garnish.

In February of 1974, several persons from out of town ventured out in a snow storm and ended up stranded in our little town. One person in particular was directed to the Community Hall, by OPP, where there was a place set up for those who were storm-stayed. A television was brought in and cookies and coffee provided.

# Maple Syrup Baked Apples

This baked apple recipe is perfect for any time of year. It will satisfy your sweet tooth with its spices and maple goodness. Pair with vanilla or maple walnut ice cream and add some nuts or fruit, for a delicious, comfort food ending to your meal.

## Ingredients:

- 4 large baking apples
- 2 tbsp lemon juice
- 1 cup apple juice
- 1/3 cup dried currants
- 1/2 cup pure maple syrup
- 1 pinch of ground cloves
- 1 pinch of ground cinnamon

#### Preparation:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.
- 2. Core apples, remove seeds, peel away a bit of skin, and stuff with currants.
- 3. Set in ovenproof baking dish.
- Combine lemon and apple juice with spices and maple syrup in a medium-sized bowl and pour over apples.
- 5. Bake uncovered for about 45 minutes, basting often.
- 6. Serve warm.


